Education: Master's in education preferred, however, highly qualified candidates with bachelor's degree and significant experience in ELA may be considered. Meets certification requirements as established by the GA Department of Education.

Experience: Academic coaching, conducted professional learning, teaching in standards-based classroom, proficiency with integrating technology into a variety of learning opportunities, and advanced written, verbal, and interpersonal skills.

Major Responsibilities: Research, plan and facilitate professional development for classroom teachers and administrators based on the GA Standards of Excellence. Provide follow up and coaching, and modeling for professional learning opportunities. Brainstorm ideas, identify resources and share innovative information to improve RESA services. Utilize up to date technology to improve delivery and engagement of professional learning for our districts. Identify and evaluate common areas of potential needs or where improvements could be realized among multiple member systems. Remain up to date on exemplary practices through self-study, conferences and other capacity building programs. Keep abreast of and build new professional skills and professional networks.
