What is Alternative Certification?

The North Georgia RESA Alternative Preparation Program is a classroom-based teacher preparation program for individuals who have the basic qualifications to teach. It is an alternative option for individuals who hold a bachelor's degree or higher but who did not complete teacher education requirements as part of their degree programs and have never been certified in any state. It is an intense internship/induction program that seeks to equip teacher-candidates with the skills to ensure a reasonable expectation of initial success in their classrooms. It puts in place a supervised internship/induction program that will help teacher-candidates move toward subsequent mastery of teaching.

We believe that an effective Teacher Alternative Preparation Program provides unique opportunities to use advanced learning in real school situations. It provides planned field experiences with supervision. It provides research-based, comprehensive content. It provides interaction with other learners and exemplary instructors.

We believe that every teacher candidate should be prepared to recognize the diversity that each learner brings to the education process and modify the learning environment to accommodate values and culture of the learner, individual learning styles, and personal experiences, as well as talents and interests.



GaTaPP Support

- Goal of GaTAPP: Equip teacher candidates with essential skills for classroom success through targeted training.
- Induction Program: Combines training with on-the-job learning, supported by supervisors, mentors, and administrators.
- Candidate Strengths: Supervisors and mentors identify candidates' skills and talents from prior experiences to ease the transition to teaching.
