



## Conditional GaTAPP Enrollment 2020-2021 Cohort Only

Due to the GACE testing site closings associated with Covid-19, the GaPSC is allowing conditional acceptance into GaTAPP for the 2020-2021 Cohort (beginning July 2020).

Candidates who have met all GaTAPP admissions requirements except passing the Program Admissions Assessment (PAA) or required GACE Content Assessment may be conditionally enrolled in the 2020 Cohort of GaTAPP at NGRESA.

Tuition for the conditionally-enrolled candidates will remain the same, and conditionally-enrolled candidates are required to complete all courses and assignments as non-conditionally enrolled candidates.

Conditionally enrolled candidates must:

- **Attempt** the PAA and/or required GACE Content assessment by December 31, 2020. An attempt is defined as all parts of the assessment being submitted and a score received.
- **Pass** the PAA and/or required GACE Content assessment by May 1, 2021.

NGRESA GaTAPP also encourages candidates to use the new at-home access to the PAA offered by GACE. Please visit <https://www.ets.org/s/cv/gace/at-home/> for more information.

Once the PAA and/or required GACE Content Assessment is passed, the candidate is no longer a Conditional GaTAPP Candidate.

If a conditionally-enrolled candidate does not meet either of the required dates stated above, he/she will be withdrawn from the NGRESA GaTAPP program on 12/31/2020 (failure to attempt either required assessment) or 5/1/2021 (failure to pass either assessment). Contingent upon GACE availability and any unforeseen delays in the opening of testing centers, these dates could be revised.

If the candidate is withdrawn from the program, the candidate will not receive any refund on tuition paid for year one of NGRESA GaTAPP. Any tuition paid toward year two will be refunded.

Conditional enrollment does not apply to the GACE Ethics Assessment (Test 360) since that assessment does not require candidates to travel to a GACE testing site for completion.

GaTAPP Candidates who have a 3.0 GPA on their most recent degree, have passed two sections on the PAA, and have attempted the third section twice may be eligible for flexibility on the Program Admissions Assessment.
