North Georgia RESA is excited to announce that we have received our initial approval from the PSC to bring the Georgia Teacher Academy for Preparation and Pedagogy (GaTAPP). GaTAPP is an alternate pathway for individuals who hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited institution, who did not complete a traditional teacher education degree program, and who want to transition to the teaching profession. The goal of the GaTAPP pathway is to equip teacher candidates with the necessary skills for initial success in their classrooms through concentrated training opportunities. Such training coupled with quality, on the job learning supported by supervisors, mentors and administrators establishes an induction program that will nurture the growth of teacher candidates.
